Scoil Bhríde, Killasonna Mixed N.S. is a co-educational, rural Catholic Primary School, situated in the parish of Granard, Co. Longford. This school has a Catholic Ethos and is under the Patronage of the Catholic Bishop of Ardagh and Clonmacnois.

The Board of Management of Scoil Bhríde invites applications for the position of Teaching Principal.

The present teaching staff comprises of three Mainstream Class Teachers (including the Principal), one Special Education Teacher and one SNA.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria of being fully registered under Route 1 (Primary) with the Teaching Council and of having 5 years' recognised teaching service, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.
