St. Brigid's GNS, Roll Number 18324C, Turret Road, Palmerstown, Dublin 20 is a Catholic school under the patronage of the Archbishop of Dublin. St. Brigid's GNS is a mainstream vertical school with one AS class "The Orchard". We currently have 328 pupils. The school has a teaching staff of 14 mainstream class teachers, 1 AS class teacher, 4 full SET posts, 1 shared SET post and an administrative Principal. We also have 7 SNAs, a full time secretary and caretaker.

The Deputy Principal role is a key leadership role in the school that will be of interest to teachers who have experience in development, implementation, operation and evaluation of innovative school based initiatives. The Deputy Principal will work in collaboration with the Principal and the ISM to ensure the effective management of the school, that all pupils have a positive educational experience and that the school fully conforms to the governance structures as set out by the Department of Education.

The roles and responsibilities for the DP post relate to the four domains of leadership and management as specified in Circular 0044/2019.
