St. John of God Primary School is a Catholic, Co-educational DEIS Band 2 status school located in the south end of Wexford Town. The Faythe School has provided a quality education to the children of Wexford since 1875.

The present teaching staff comprises currently of 1 Admin Principal, 11 Class Teachers, 7 SET, 1 EAL, 1 ASD Teacher, 1 HSCL and 8 SNAs.

Our aim is to develop each child's personal, spiritual and educational potential in a respectful, friendly, safe and inclusive teaching and learning environment in collaboration with parents, guardians and the wider community.

Applicants must be registered with the Teaching Council of Ireland (Route 1 - Primary), be fully Garda vetted and have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in a recognised primary school in Ireland.

An understanding and a commitment to the school's Catholic ethos and an ability to support and promote school/parish links.

An in-depth knowledge of the Primary Curriculum and a range of teaching experience. Understanding and knowledge of the requirements associated with the provision of Special Education Needs, inclusion and diversity. Evidence of ongoing experience in the provision of education to children in an ASD class and the facilitation of their educational provision. Evidence of management and communication skills as well as evidence of the ability to foster positive relationships with pupils, parents and the wider community. Evidence of the leadership skills associated with all aspects of school life with particular reference to school self-evaluation and curricular development. Evidence of commitment to relevant and ongoing continuing professional development.
